As with previous years, I would like to stress the importance that this Initiative is to add to all the different powerful Prayer Initiatives, currently flowing in our Nation. Together we persist in faithful Prayer!

I felt a need in my heart to have a shift in our approach to this Prayer Meeting and to establish more of a Prayer Action.

Firstly, I invite all of you to prayerfully consider joining us in our Up4SA 2020 Prayer Action. Please confirm with me participation and availability to serve as a Prayer point Coordinator in your area at your earliest convenience. Secondly, I invite you to consider assisting me as a Provincial Coordinator, this will enable us to mobilize the smaller Communities and Towns in your area and Province. Kindly let me know soonest if you are prompted by the Holy Spirit to fulfil this roll.

Up4SA Prayer Action 2020:

Planning:

- **Date: Sunday 1 March 2020**
- **Time: 11h -14h**
- Organize and arrange approval for the use of a Private or Municipal property at one of the entrances (or all entrances) to your Town i.e. corner of School grounds, Church property etc. We are going to build Altars (signs) for the Lord.
- Mobilize the Christian Community. Encourage them to bring a stone from their Area (picked up at home, in neighbourhood etc.) to the meeting place, which will form part of an Altar. Every person can either write a Scripture on their stone with the Area they are from or write the Name of Jesus on their stone, etc. The Planning Committee can lay the foundation of the Altar in the weeks building up to the **Prayer Action**.

If your Area/Community already has an Altar, as mentioned above, I suggest praying about it, mobilizing people in your area to add their stones to the current Altar.

This Altar/sign will symbolize:

- Unity - Psalm 133:1-3

- Jesus the Cornerstone of our Community and Nation – Eph. 2:19-22
 - Body of Christ as Living stones (Nation Builders) - 1 Pet 2:5
- Thanksgiving for past deliverance and trust for future deliverance - Joshua 4:8
- The restoration of a Spiritual reverence and Honour to God as the only Father of our Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour - 1 Kings 18:30

Other info:

Pamphlet with the “Arrangements and Prayer Guidelines” will be available at each meeting place.
No sound system required.

No official Programs! We trust the Lord that Prayer, songs, shofars, flags etc. will be authentic and spontaneous.

Coordinators and their Helpers will hand out the “Arrangements and Prayer Guidelines” pamphlets and explain details to individuals, if necessary.

Prayer can take place, as a family, individually, or as a group at specific times (led by the Holy Spirit). People can come and go between 11h and 14h to Pray and Worship, with no specific “programmed event” taking place.

I suggest as a focus point (as per previous years), we plant a Cross in the middle or next to the Altar.

Scripture:

Isa 45:8 Drop down, ye heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down RIGHTEOUSNESS: let the earth open, and let them bring forth SALVATION, and let RIGHTEOUSNESS spring up together; I the LORD have created it.

Prophetic message prompted in my spirit that will be included in the pamphlet:

Gen. 19:26 Stop looking back to the past. Our Nation will stay in bondage like Lot’s wife as a pillar of salt if we do not embrace the Biblical truth of Gal. 3:28, as the future as one in Christ!

Lastly, I want to suggest that every Area/Town will consider partaking in the first week of the "7 Days on the Wall" 24/7 Prayer Initiative for Revival in South Africa by Jericho Walls. (24 February to 1 March 2020). Different Churches in every Town can take for example 1 day out of the 7 days to pray, filling up the week of Prayer slots. I believe this will create focus, promote local unity and impetus towards the Prayer Action on the 7th day! The Prayer focus for the "7 Days on the Wall" 24/7 Prayer Initiative will be based on three promises in Scripture. Spiritual Awakening - Isaiah 62:6,7. Salvation of the unsaved - Acts 15:16,17. Social Justice - Luke 18:7,8. All information regarding the Initiative will be communicated to you.
