Dear Colleagues,

I trust that you are all well. Regarding prospective students in your constituency be advised about the important matters concerning the applications of students into ministry within the AFM of SA:

1. That the due date for registration of students at the University of North West (NWU) will close within the next month or two. The student who wants to enter the ministry in the AFM of SA must apply online with NWU for the academic year 2021. This application with NWU will set the internal processes in motion so that students will not be disappointed because of late applications.
2. That the AFM of SA has applied for recognition as a Private Higher Learning Institution in Theology, on the BTH Degree level. Up to date, we have not yet received confirmation that will enable us to enroll a student for this proposed degree. I am aware that some students did not register this year because they were waiting for this proposed AFM Degree. They have missed a year, and if the AFM does not receive a confirmation for enrolling students this year, these prospective students will experience another delay. This delay will mean that their entrance into ministry in the AFM will have postponed for two years.
3. That the historical arrangement between the AFM of SA and the Auckland Park Theological College has lapsed. The NLF may institute more stringent conditions for entrance into the ministry of the AFM of SA or even refuse to accept the qualification for admission to become a minister in the AFM of SA.

In light of the above, we urge you to circularize this information to all your assemblies, so that prospective students may be fully informed when making decisions to enroll for entrance to the ministry in the AFM of SA.
