**CIRCULARIZATION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE APOSTOLIC FAITH  
MISSION OF SOUTH AFRICA.**

In terms of Section 12.1 of the constitution of the Apostolic Faith Mission of South Africa: "To amend this constitution in any way, a written notice shall be submitted via a Regional Leadership Forum, Department or Theological Training Institution, or be submitted by the National Leadership Form and must reach the General Secretary at least ninety (90) days prior to the next General Business Meeting. In this notice full particulars of the proposed amendment/s including a motivation thereof must be given. Thereafter notice shall be circularised at least sixty (60) days prior to the General Business Meeting and a two thirds majority vote of the members present at the General Business Meeting shall decide whether or not the constitution shall be so amended."

Included below is the relevant existing clause, with the proposed amendments in **blue**.

**Appendix 10 A8.4.1** currently reads as follows:

"Holiday leave for a pastor will be calculated as follows from the date of his/her legitimation: "

It is proposed that it should be: "*Holiday leave for a pastor will be calculated as follows from the date of effective employment after ordination and the first call:*"

The aim and motivation of the proposed amendment is to create clarity about the date on which the calculation of years of service and subsequently holiday leave, starts.
