I trust that you are well and still staying positive during the interesting and sometimes challenging experiences brought about by the Covid-19 pandemic. For many of our assemblies, pastors and members it was and still is, not easy. Please be ensured of the thoughts and prayers of the National Office Bearers (NOB). We must continue to be channels of Faith and Hope.

IN THIS CIRCULAR I AM PROVIDING YOU WITH INFORMATION ON THE PLANNED GBM.

1. **Official notice of the GBM.** All Assembly delegates, National Leadership Forum (NLF) Members, Representatives of church's Departments and Standing Committees are invited to attend the General Business Meeting (GBM), which will be organized over two days.

Notice is hereby given that the GBM will take place from 10:00 on Tuesday 16 November 2021 and 09:00 on Wednesday 17 November 2021 at Word and Life in Boksburg and multiple other venues, for the purposes of electing the National Office Bearers of the AFM of SA, receive reports and approve minutes and amendments.

2. **Explanation of the process of organizing and registering for the GBM.**

Considering the Covid 19 Pandemic, the GBM as scheduled for September 2020 could not take place. Different possible dates were considered by the NLF, none of which could be practically realized up to date.

The NLF has subsequently discussed the matter and resolved that notice be given of a GBM to be organized as one meeting, from a main venue whilst simultaneously connecting multiple venues across the country by means of on-line (Zoom) technology.

The main venue will be Word and Life church in Boksburg. **Delegates from assemblies will be allocated to specific GBM venues according to their Regions/Networks.** Delegates must attend at the GBM venue indicated on their registration confirmation letter. These venues will consist of AFM assembly facilities around the country with the necessary capacity regarding space, the lockdown regulations and the relevant technology. The meeting is planned for two days being on Tuesday and Wednesday.

Delegates are requested to commence with registration immediately according to the registration process as indicated on the registration form. This will enable timeous preparation on the side of the national administration and the different GBM venues.

Observers will be limited to scrutineers and individuals involved in administrative duties.

2.1 REGISTRATION FEE AND PROCESS: R350-00 per person. Registrations and payment via EFT, will be open from 18 September 2021. **Please note that there will be no registrations on the day that the GBM commences. All registrations must be completed by 1 November 2021.**

Assemblies must complete the registration form for each delegate, make the payments and forward the completed registration forms with proof of payment to their Regional Secretary/ Administrator as soon as possible.

The Regional Secretary/ Administrator will confirm the registrations and forward the registration forms and proof of payment to the National Office, who will issue a proof of registration letter for each delegate. The proof of registration letter with the QR code printed on it, must be brought to the specific venue indicated on the letter, where it will be used to verify registration and attendance to the GBM.

2.2 ACCOMMODATION:

Delegates must organize their own accommodation close to the venue to enable them to attend the meeting as planned over the two days.
